Redmond is the regional provider of Advanced Life Support (ALS) services in northeast King County. We currently operate three Medic One units and one Medical Services Officer (paramedic supervisor) unit staffed by our 35 paramedics. University of Washington, School of Medicine (Harborview) trained paramedics. Our ALS staff serves a population in excess of 270,000 throughout Redmond, Kirkland, Woodinville, Duvall, and the northern portions of Sammamish; an area of nearly 200-square
