

ORDINANCE: 1725

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
SETTING 1993 SALARIES FOR REPRESENTED POLICE
SUPPORT SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, reorganization of the police records and communications functions calls for the addition of two new supervisory positions which are represented by the Redmond Police Officers Association (Police Support bargaining unit), necessitating amendment of Pay Plan C-1 - RPOA (Support); now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "Pay Plan C-1 - RPOA (Support)", as adopted by Ordinance 1724 is hereby amended adding the classifications of Police Records Supervisor and Communications Supervisor to the plan, as set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. The changes to Pay Plan C-1 called for in this ordinance shall be effective as of 1 January 1993.




