## ORDINANCE NO. 55.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR THE DRIVER OF ANY VEHICLE TRAVELING ON ANY STREET IN THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WHERE A STOP SIGN HAS BEEN POSTED, TO FAIL TO STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF SUCH STREET, AND ANY HEAVILY TRAVELED COUNTY AND STATE HIGHWAY, AND FIXING THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person driving or or operating any vehicle on any street in the Town of Redmond, upon which has been posted the "STOP" notice, and who shall fail to bring the vehicle so driven or operated to a complete stop at the point where said street intersects any heavily traveled State or County Highway.

SECTION II. Any person violating any provision of this ORDINANCE shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$50.00.
