

ORDINANCE NO. 53.

AN ORDINANCE fixing the time and place of meeting of the Town Council, providing for attendance at said meetings; and repealing ordinances No. 2, 20, and 22 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND,

Section I. Regular meetings of the Town Council shall be held on the first and third Wednesday of each month at the hour of eight o'clock P. M., in Allen's Hall in said town.

Section II. Special meetings of the Town Council may be called at any time by the mayor or by three councilmen by serving a written notice upon each member at least three hours before the time specified for said meeting.

Section III. A majority of the members of the Town Council shall constitute a quorum; but a lesser number may adjourn from time to time and may, at such meeting, notify all absent members to be present at the time to which said meeting is adjourned. In the event of their failure so to do they shall be subject to a penalty of \$5.00 and any absent member receiving such notice and failing to attend shall be assessed said penalty of \$5.00. If same is not paid it shall be collected in the court of any justice of the peace having jurisdiction thereof.

Section IV. That ordinances No. 2, 20 and 22, and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
