

ORDINANCE No. 46.

An Ordinance Prohibiting The Use And Sale Of Fireworks And Fixing
A Penalty For Violations Thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND AS FOLLOWS:-

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person to use, fire, discharge, sell or offer for sale any torpedo, bomb, squib, blank cartridge or pistol for the use of same, explosive cane, Roman candle, sky rocket, firecracker or fireworks of any kind or nature whatsoever within the limits of the Town of Redmond.

SECTION II. Any person violating any provision of this ORDINANCE shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by both.

SECTION III. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
