ORDINANCE NO. 38

An Ordinance creating Local Improvement District No. 1 providing for the Improvement of Kirkland Street from the West line of Lot 7 in Block 5 of Sikes' First Addition to Redmond, to Union Street; and Union Street from Kirkland Street to Jackson Street, by grading the same, providing for the necessary surface drainage, gravelling the roadways and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, and providing that the entire cost of such improvement shall be paid by special assessment on the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law.

Whereas, public necessity and convenience demand that the above named streets be improved by grading, providing for the necessary surface drainage and by grading the roadways; and

Whereas, such improvement will be a special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:-

Section 1. That Kirkland Street from the West line of Lot 7 in Block 5 of Sikes' First Addition to Redmond, to Union Street; and Union Street from Kirkland Street to Jackson Street be and the same are hereby ordered improved by grading the same, providing for the necessary surface drainage by gravelling the roadways and doing such other work as may be necessary in connection therewith, the same to be known as Local Improvement District No. \_\_\_\_\_.

Section 2. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law and that no part thereof shall be paid from the general fund of the town of Redmond.



Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
