

ORDINANCE 36.

An ORDINANCE providing for the construction, reconstruction and repair of sidewalks within the corporate limits of the Town of Redmond, King County, Washington, prescribing the material for and the manner of building same, and providing a penalty for violation hereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Redmond as follows:

Section 1. All sidewalks, on either side of the streets and avenues of the Town of Redmond, in front of or along any lot, lots or lands abutting on same, which shall hereafter be constructed, reconstructed or replaced, shall be of cement. No person shall construct, reconstruct or replace any such sidewalk of any other material within the limits of this Town.

Section 2. Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall desire to repair any now existing sidewalk constructed with any other material than is herein prescribed, he or they shall first secure a permit from the Town Council before such work is undertaken. In no such case shall a permit be granted where the amount of repairs in the aggregate exceeds one-third (1/3) of the running feet in said walk.

Section 3. Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall desire to construct, reconstruct or replace any sidewalk he, or they, shall first secure a permit from the Town Council before work is undertaken and at the same time shall secure from the Town Engineer and Council grade lines and specifications for such walks.

Section 4. Any sidewalk constructed, reconstructed, repaired or replaced in any other manner than provided in this ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance and shall be abated at the order of the Town Council, and any person, firm or corporation building or procuring or causing such sidewalk to be built shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars or more than Fifty Dollars and shall stand committed until such fine be paid.
