

ORDINANCE #29.

An Ordinance Governing The Conservation Of Town Water, And Providing For The Protection Of The Town Water System, And Fixing Penalties For The Infringement Thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful for any person to waste Town Water through open or leaky faucets or through broken or leaky pipes, or in any other manner whatsoever

SECTION II.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to interfere with or damage in any way the Town Water System, including the dam, pipeline, hydrants, valve-boxes, or any part whatsoever of the Town Water System.

SECTION III.

Any person violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Two Dollars and not exceeding Five Dollars.

Upon each succeeding conviction the punishment shall be by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars and not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars.

No water shall be furnished to any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this Ordinance until all fines are paid.
