

RESOLUTION NO. 85

A RESOLUTION favoring the passage of Senate  
Bill No. 136 known as the Metropolitan Council  
Act.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 136, known as the Metropolitan Council  
Act, has been introduced in the Regular Session of The Washington State  
Senate, and

WHEREAS said Bill provides for machinery for solution of  
Metropolitan area-wide problems beyond the ability of individual cities  
and counties to solve for themselves, and

WHEREAS, said Bill preserves the autonomy of cities and towns  
in all respects except the control of pollution, and

WHEREAS, said Bill, will make it possible to solve the pollution  
problem existing in Lake Washington, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND that  
said Bill be passed and enacted into law, and hereby requests the Senator  
and Representatives of the 46th Legislative District to cast their votes  
in favor of Senate Bill No. 136.
