

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO 62

A RESOLUTION ordering the construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland Street in the Town of Redmond from the east line of Union street to the west line of Adair street and on the east side of Adair street from the south line of Kirkland street to the north line of Jackson street; creating a "Sidewalk Construction Fund NO.2" and providing for the levying of special assessments against the property owners abutting on the improvement.

WHEREAS, pursuant to resolution passed the 9th day of September, 1953, after due notice having been given by publication and mailing in the manner provided by law, a public hearing was held before the Town Council this day, at which hearing the Town Council heard all persons desiring to appear for or against the construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland street in the Town of Redmond from the east line of Union street to the west line of Adair street and on the east side of Adair street from the south line of Kirkland street to the north line of Jackson street, and the Town Council having determined to proceed with the improvement, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The construction of a concrete sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland street in the Town of Redmond from the east line of Union street to the west line of Adair street and on the east side of Adair street from the south line of Kirkland street to the north line of Jackson street is hereby ordered and the proper Town officials are hereby directed to proceed with said improvement.

Section 2. There is hereby created in the office of the Town treasurer a "Sidewalk Construction Fund NO.2", into which fund shall be paid all payments on assessments levied against the property owners abutting upon the improvement for the payment of the costs of the improvement. Warrants shall be drawn on said fund for payment of all costs of the improvement.

Section 3. When the final costs of said improvement are ascertained, the Town Engineer shall prepare an assessment roll which shall to the extent necessary be based on benefits and which shall describe the property assessed, the name of the owner if known, otherwise stating that the owner is unknown, and fixing the amount of the assessment. The assessment roll shall be filed with the Town Clerk and when so filed the Council shall by resolution fix the date for hearing thereon and direct the Clerk to give notice of such hearing and the time and place thereof in the manner provided by law, at which hearing the Town

Council shall by ordinance confirm, modify or reject or order recasting of the assessment roll. The full amount of the assessment shall be paid in one payment within thirty days after the filing with the Town Treasurer for collection of the final assessment roll as confirmed. The amount of the assessment shall become a lien against the property described therein from the date of the filing of the roll with the Town Treasurer for collection..
