

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 59

A RESOLUTION declaring the intention of the Town Council to order the construction of a sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland Street in the Town of Redmond from a point 142 feet east of the east line of First Avenue to the west line of Union Street; providing that the costs of such improvement shall all be borne by the abutting property owners with the exception of a portion crossing a 16 foot alley; and fixing the time and place for hearing on this resolution.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 177 of the 1949 Session Laws of the State of Washington, it is the intention of the Town Council of the Town of Redmond to order the construction of ~~a concrete~~ sidewalk on the southside of Kirkland Street in the Town of Redmond from a point feet east of the east line of First Avenue to the west line of Union Street. All of the costs of such improvement shall be borne by the abutting property owners and assessments shall be made against said abutting property in accordance with law, with the exception that the cost of constructing such sidewalk across the 16 foot alley presently located on the west side of Block 2, of White's School House Addition, King County, Washington, shall be borne by the Town out of funds presently on hand.

Section 2. A hearing shall be held on this resolution at 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the 9th day of September, 1953, in the Council Chambers, Town Hall, Redmond, Washington, at which hearing the Council shall hear persons who appear for and against the improvement, and determine whether it will or will not proceed with the improvement and whether it will make any changes in the original plan, and what the changes shall be.

Section 3. The Town Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published for two consecutive weeks in the Lake Sammamish News, the first publication to be no later than August 27, 1953, and the Town Clerk shall give notice of the date of such hearing, at least ten days before the date fixed for such hearing, to each owner or reputed owner of the abutting

property by mailing to the owner or reputed owner of the property as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer at the address shown thereon a notice of the date of hearing.

PASSED by the Town Council at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 26th day of August, 1953.
