

RESOLUTION No. 5455

WHEREAS, the estimated Budget of the Town of Redmond for the year 1952 has been found to be inadequate for the proper functioning of certain Town Departments, and

WHEREAS, the Street Fund and the Water Revenue Construction Funds of the Town of Redmond are depleted and it is vitally in the interests of the Town that certain bills be paid which have been presented on such funds,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Redmond,

1. That the Town Clerk ~~is~~ hereby authorized to make payment of \$ 90.84 in excess of the amount budgeted for Library expenses, as well as the sum of \$ 1,000.00 in excess of the amount budgeted for the Police Department expenses, and
2. That the Town ^{Treasurer} ~~Clerk~~ is hereby authorized to transfer from the Current Expense Fund the amounts as follows to be placed to the credit of the following Funds:

For Street Fund \$ 500.00;

For Water Revenue
Construction Fund \$ 1696.55.
