RESOLUTION NO. 51

Whereas, extension of the water system of the Town of Redmond, has become necessary in order to accommodate new users of the said system, and

Whereas, the said new users have guaranteed to pay all costs of the said extension, and

Whereas, the State of Washington requires that the Town of Redmond furnish a surety bond in the amount of \$1,000.00 to protect the State against future damage, and to insure proper restoration of ditches, slopes, and cleanup of right of way upon completion of the work, the said bond to run for one year from date of completion, which is estimated at April 15, 1951, and

Whereas, the work above referred to is in connection with State Franchise Application No. 2140, made by the Town of Redmond, to construct, operate and maintain approximately 435 feet of pipe line along and across a portion of Primary State Highway No. 2, in King County for a period of 25 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Redmond, that Lewis Green, Mayor is hereby authorized to make application for and purchase a surety bond in the amount of \$1,000.00 running to the State of Washington, as hereinabove set forth, for and on behalf of the Town of Redmond.
