

WHEREAS the Town of Redmond has need for certain public improvements and desires to employ competent engineers to make surveys toward that end,

Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Redmond accept the proposal of the engineering firm of H. T. Harstad and Associates, consulting engineers, empowering said H. T. Harstad and Associates to begin work on an engineering survey as outlined in proposed agreement of August 23, 1950, as hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

Gentlemen:

In accordance with your request, we are pleased to submit the following proposal for Engineering Services in connection with proposed improvements to your water system and a proposed sewer system and disposal plant.

We will provide the necessary Engineering Services and will advise and assist in the preparation of an "Application for Advance Plan Preparation for Non-Federal Public Works" (Public Law 352, 81st Congress).

Our charges for Engineering Services and the terms and conditions under which we operate conform to those recommended by the American Society of Civil Engineers. Engineering fees will be as follows:

<u>Item:</u>	<u>Engineering Fee as % of Cost of Project</u>
Preliminary Studies and Report, Preparation of Plans and Specifications.	5- $\frac{1}{2}$ %
General Supervision of Construction, assistance in call for Bids and as built drawings.	2 %
Layout and Field Inspection during Construction	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ %

Unless otherwise authorized, payment of fees will be limited under this agreement to Federal Planning Funds received by the Town of Redmond and to funds from bond issues for financing of the proposed improvements.

If this proposal is accepted we will proceed with the preparation of the necessary application for Federal Planning Funds and as soon as the Planning Loan is granted we will proceed with preparation of plans and specifications for the proposed work.

In the interim we will proceed with the preliminary engineering and economic studies so as to be in a position to advise the Council on matters pertaining to these improvements.
