

TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION NO. 70

A RESOLUTION declaring the intention of the Town Council to order the construction of drainage facilities within the following described area, providing that the costs of such improvement shall all be borne by the property owners within said area; and fixing the time and place for hearing on this resolution .

Beginning at the center of the intersection of Kirkland Avenue and Faulds St.; Thence north along the centerline of Faulds St. extended, to the centerline of Elias St. extended; Thence west along the centerline of Elias St. to the west boundary of 3rd Ave; Thence south along said west boundary of 3rd Ave. to a point 135' north of the centerline of Maple St; Thence west along a line 135' north of and parallel to the centerline of Maple St. to the east boundary of 1st Ave; Thence south along the east boundary of 1st Ave. to a point 255' south of the centerline of Maple St; Thence west to a point 238.7' west of the centerline of 1st Ave.; Thence South 238.7' west of and parallel to 1st Ave. to a point 132.5' north of the centerline of Fir St.; Thence west 132.5' north of and parallel to the centerline of Fir St. to the Corporate Limits of the Town of Redmond; Thence south along said Corporate Limits to the centerline of Kirkland Ave.; Thence east along the centerline of Kirkland Avenue to the centerline of 1st Ave.; Thence south along the centerline of 1st Ave. to the centerline of Primary State Highway No. 2; Thence easterly along the centerline of State Highway No. 2 to the centerline of Union St.; Thence north along the centerline of Union St. to the centerline of Kirkland Ave.; Thence east to the point of beginning.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 177 of the 1949 Session Laws of the State of Washington, it is the intention of the Town Council of the Town of Redmond to order the construction of drainage facilities within the above described area. All of the costs of such improvement shall be borne by the owners of property within the area and assessments shall be made against such property in accordance with law.

Section 2. A hearing shall be held on this resolution at 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the <sup>th</sup> 18 day of August, 1954, in the Council Chambers, Town Hall, Redmond, Washington, at which hearing the Council shall hear persons who appear for and against the improvement, and determine whether it will or will not proceed with the improvement and whether it will make any changes in the original plan, and what the changes shall be.

Section 3. The Town Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published for two consecutive weeks in the Sammamish Valley News, the first publication to be no later than July 18, 1954, and the Town Clerk shall give notice of the date of such hearing, at least ten days before the date fixed for such hearing, to each owner or reputed owner of the property by mailing to the owner or reputed owner of the property as shown on the tax rolls of the County Treasurer at the address shown thereon a notice of the date of hearing.
