WHEREAS the people of the Town of Redmond are desirous of honoring the name of Albert Anderson, who, during his lifetime contributed much to the betterment of Redmond and to its Park, having served as Superintendent therefore for many years,

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the town council of the town of Redmond:

That the triangular piece of property in the town of Redmond, formerly known as the Town Park, and bounded on the West by Union Street, on the Northerly by Jackson Street, and on the Southerly by Railroad Avenue and P.S. Highway No. 2, shall henceforth be known as "ALBERT ANDERSON MEMORIAL PARK".
