

RESOLUTION No. 59

WHEREAS, Northwest Greyhound Lines has filed an application with the State Department of Transportation to enable it to continue to operate its buses from Seattle over the Lake Washington Bridge through Kirkland to Redmond and return, and

WHEREAS, the present frequency of bus service to the town of Redmond and its vicinity, particularly that territory lying between Redmond and Kirkland, depends upon continued service by Northwest Greyhound Lines. It is therefore of prime importance to the residents of Redmond and its vicinity that the application mentioned above be granted. It would be considerably against the interests of this community if such service were curtailed, thereby reducing the frequency of service to Redmond and depriving residents between Redmond and Kirkland of a through service to and from Seattle.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Council of the town of Redmond endorse the application of Northwest Greyhound Lines referred to above and hereby requests the Department of Transportation to grant this application that the present service maintained by Northwest Greyhound Lines in this vicinity may be continued in the future.
