A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING UPON A PETITION FOR VACATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, CITY FILE NO. L040099.

WHEREAS, a petition for vacation of a right-of-way has been filed with the office of the City Clerk, signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting the right-of-way to be vacated, which is a portion of NE 91<sup>st</sup> Street located due west of 166<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE at the end of the NE 91<sup>st</sup> Street corridor, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held for the purpose of considering said petition for a right-of-way vacation, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

A public hearing upon the petition for vacation of a certain public right-of-way known as NE 91<sup>st</sup> Street, located due west of 166<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE at the end of the NE 91<sup>st</sup> Street corridor, in the City of Redmond, Washington, City file no. L040099, shall be held in the City Council Chambers at the Redmond Public Safety Building at 8:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard on January 4, 2005, which is not less than 20 days nor more than 60 days from the date of passage of this resolution, at which time all persons interested in said right-of-way vacation are invited to appear and be heard. The City Clerk and Planning Director are directed to post, publish and mail

notices of said hearing at least 20 days prior to the date set for hearing, pursuant to RCW 35.79.020 and Redmond Community Development Guide Section 20F.30.50.
