## RESOLUTION NO. 1229

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM (WWRP) **PROJECT** TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR **OUTDOOR** RECREATION (IAC) AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.15 RCW.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond has approved a comprehensive park plan, the 2004 Parks, Recreation, and Open Space (PRO Plan), that includes the Grass Lawn Community Park project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond approved the Grass Lawn Park Renovation Study in 2001. As a result of the study, the soccer field, the primary softball field, and the tennis courts were upgraded in Phases I (2003) and II (2004). Phase III involves demolishing the former house and constructing restrooms, a neighborhood picnic shelter, and maintenance facility. The existing tot lot and the basketball courts could be renovated or replaced with different recreational elements; and

WHEREAS, in 2005 the City allocated \$1,230,000 for Phase III renovations to Grass Lawn Community Park;

WHEREAS, in May 2006, the City selected Bruce Dees and Associates to prepare preliminary design, final design, and construction plans for Phase III; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of WWRP, state funding assistance is requested to aid in financing the cost of some of park renovations identified above; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond considers it is in the best public interest to renovate Grass Lawn Community Park; now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make formal application to the 2006 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for funding assistance in the amount of \$300,000;

Section 2. Any funding assistance received as the result of this application shall be used in the renovation of Phase III of Grass Lawn Community Park;

Section 3. The City of Redmond's monetary share of the project shall be derived from 2006 Park Capital Improvement Funds (CIP);

Section 4. The City of Redmond acknowledges that the City is responsible for supporting all non-cash commitments to the sponsor share should they not materialize;

Section 5. The City of Redmond acknowledges that any facility developed with IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the Redmond City Council and IAC;

Section 6. This Resolution becomes part of a formal application to IAC; and.

Section 7. The City of Redmond has provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
