ORDINANCE NO. 2794**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING RMC 13.18.060 TO ADD A
STORMWATER RATE ADJUSTMENT OF .3 FOR STATE
HIGHWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, stormwater is an important environmental concern for all citizens of the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, billing of stormwater provides the revenue for the City to design, construct, and maintain the stormwater system; and

WHEREAS, stormwater billing is based on the amount of impervious surface on each parcel of land within the City and modified by rate adjustments; and

WHEREAS, transportation rights-of-way contribute stormwater runoff to the stormwater system; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature amended RCW 90.03.525 to provide greater flexibility for jurisdictions to bill the Department of Transportation for stormwater on state highway rights-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature. The amendments to the Redmond

Municipal Code set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance shall become a part of the City Code. The remainder of this ordinance shall not be codified.

Section 2. Adoption of Section. RMC 13.18.060, Rate Adjustment, is hereby amended to include subsection H:

H. Developed rights-of-way designated as state highways shall have a fixed single rate adjustment of 0.3, notwithstanding any other provision of this section.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective five days after passage and publication of an approved summary consisting of the title, or as otherwise provided by law.


