

ORDINANCE NO. 2085

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON,
ESTABLISHING A FIREFIGHTER PENSION FUND AND
AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FROM THE NEWLY CREATED
FUND.

WHEREAS, appropriate funds should be created to facilitate budgeting and accounting of expenditures for the payment of firefighter pension benefits, and

WHEREAS, R.C.W. 41.16 and 41.18 governs the City of Redmond's responsibility to pay for firefighter pension benefits for those firefighters that qualify for pension benefits under the Firemen's Pension and Relief Act, 1955, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON
HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Creation of Fund. There is created a new fiduciary fund within the treasury of the city for the sole purpose of accounting for revenues received and expenses incurred for firefighter pension benefits for those firefighters that qualify for pension benefits under the Firemen's Pension and Relief Act, 1955.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3 Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the city legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of a summary thereof consisting of the title.
