CATEGORY	REQUIREMENT
<b>AGE</b>	18 years of age at time of application. Age 21 for members of the Citizens Patrol
<b>US CITIZEN</b>	No, with the exception of Commissioned assignments
<b>HIGH SCHOOL GRAD/GED</b>	Yes
<b>VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE</b>	Washington State Driver's License required at time of hire. Or other approved I.D.
<b>FELONY CONVICTION(S) AS AN ADULT</b>	No felony convictions allowed.
<b>FELONY CONVICTION(S) AS A JUVENILE</b>	None
<b>ABILITY TO READ &amp; SPEAK THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE</b>	Ability to read, write and speak fluent English.
<b>TIME COMMITMENT</b>	Due to the time it takes to conduct the selection process, the Redmond Police Department does ask for at least a one year commitment in the volunteer program

<b><i>AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFIERS</i></b>	<b>THE FOLLOWING ARE <i>AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFIERS</i> - APPLICANTS SHOULD NOT APPLY TO OUR AGENCY IF THEY INDICATE ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:</b>
<b>Driving</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 or more traffic crime convictions in last 5 years (DWI, Suspended, Reckless, etc).</li> <li>• Suspension of driver's license within past 5 years.</li> <li>• 3 or more moving violations in the past 3 years</li> <li>• 1 or more at-fault accidents in past 3 years</li> </ul>
<b>Drug Use</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sold marijuana, narcotics, or dangerous drugs</li> <li>• All illegal drug use will be closely scrutinized on a case by case basis</li> <li>• Had a pattern of abusing prescription medication</li> </ul>
<b>Criminal Activity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any adult felony conviction.</li> <li>• Any misdemeanor, or felony conviction while employed in a criminal justice capacity.</li> <li>• Adult misdemeanor convictions will be carefully reviewed.</li> <li>• Been convicted of any crime under a domestic violence statute.</li> <li>• Unlawful sexual misconduct.</li> </ul>
<b>Employment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Been dishonorably discharged from the United States armed forces.</li> <li>• Lied during any stage of the hiring process.</li> <li>• Falsified his or her application, personal history questionnaire, or any other forms during hiring process.</li> </ul>
<b><i>Discretionary Disqualifiers</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Alcohol or substance misuse and/or abuse</li> <li>• Excessive traffic violations</li> <li>• Commission of a felony</li> <li>• Any other conduct or pattern of conduct that would tend to disrupt, diminish, or otherwise jeopardize public trust in the law enforcement profession.</li> <li>• Inability to perform the essential functions of a police volunteer</li> </ul>
