

Redmond Firefighters

- Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) providing "basic life support" (BLS) services to sick or injured
- CPR, splinting, wound care, oxygen therapy, and defibrillation
- Vehicle extrication, hazardous material response and mitigation, non-emergency service calls
- Search and rescue, high and low angle rescue, confined space and trench rescue
- Emergency apparatus and equipment maintenance, and life safety inspections, and fire code enforcement.





Northeast King County Medic One

- Redmond is the regional provider of Advanced Life Support (ALS) services in northeast King County.
- We currently operate three Medic One units and one Medical Services Officer (paramedic supervisor) unit staffed by our 35
- University of Washington, School of Medicine (Harborview) trained paramedics. Our ALS staff serves a population in excess of 270,000 throughout Redmond, Kirkland, Woodinville, Duvall, and the northern portions of Sammamish; an area of nearly 200-square miles.
- The three medic units answer more than 6000 ALS calls annually.
