## AMENDMENT TO INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR DISPATCH SERVICES

THIS AMENDMENT amends that certain Interlocal Agreement ("the Agreement") entered into between the City of Redmond, Washington and the City of Duvall, Washington for police dispatch services during the calendar years 2011 and 2012.

WHEREAS, the Agreement was executed by the parties in October 2010 in order for the City of Redmond to provide police dispatch services to the City of Duvall, including services related to the entry of certain data into the Washington Crime Information Center (WACIC) and the ACCESS information system operated by the Washington State Patrol, and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that the City of Duvall will enter stolen property information into WACIC and the Access Information Systems and the parties desire to amend the Agreement in order to provide that the City of Redmond will do so and that the City of Duvall will pay for such services, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF DUVALL AND THE CITY OF REDMOND HEREBY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- **Stolen Property Information.** Subsection (B)(4) of Exhibit A to the Agreement 1. is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 4. Redmond will enter stolen property information into the Washington Crime Information Center (WACIC) and the ACCESS information system operated by the Washington State Patrol.
- **Payment.** A new Subsection 1.10 is hereby added to the Agreement to read as 2. follows:
  - 1.11 In addition to the payments provided for in Subsection 1.10. Duvall will pay Redmond for entry of stolen property information into WACIC and ACCESS as follows:

Entry of up to 100 items: \$1,000 Entry of 101-150 items: \$1.500 Entry of 151-200 items: \$2,000

Entry of over 200 items: \$100 for each item

over 200 (i.e., \$2,000 for the first 200 items + \$100 for each

additional item)

**Effect.** Except as expressly amended by this Amendment, all provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
