



Amendments to Small Animal Husbandry Policies and Codes A Component of the 2010-2011 Periodic Update to Redmond's Comprehensive Plan

The Redmond Planning Commission is scheduled to begin review of staff recommended amendments to small animal husbandry policies and codes. The following tentative schedule includes study sessions and a public hearing during which community members may provide verbal and written comment regarding the amendments:

- ◇ September 21—study session
- ◇ October 12—public hearing and study session
- ◇ October 19—study session, if necessary

The recommended amendments revise the Redmond Municipal Code regarding chickens. Included is a zone-based provision for chicken husbandry in single-family zones along with siting and animal care criteria.

Following the Planning Commission's approval and recommendation to the City Council, the Council will consider the amendments and take action as part of the 2010-2011 periodic update the Comprehensive Plan. The Council's action is tentatively scheduled for December 6, 2011.
