STUDY SESSION SUMMARY

Sustainability Presentation – Robert Pantley

Mr. Robert Pantley, Managing Partner of Natural and Built Environments, LLC and Environmentally Wise Investments, LLC, introduced members of his staff and provided a presentation to the Mayor and Members of the Council entitled, "The Sustainable Revolution – A Better Way."
